Accommodation and Overnight Arrangements

- We have exclusive use of the accommodation block during our stay and will be the only school using the centre during our residential.
- The accommodation block is split into 2 dormitories (1 for boys, 1 for girls) consisting of bunkbeds.
- There are 2 staff bedrooms – one next to each dorm.
- There is an area to relax at the end of the day where we will watch a DVD before bedtime.
- Pupils will need to make up their own beds with a fitted sheet, pillow case and sleeping bag (we will try to get videos of this for your entertainment!!!)

Meal Times

- Day One Lunch – **packed lunch provided by parents.**
- Evening Meal – Take Away from local Pizza Shop.
- Breakfast is self-serve cereals, fruit juice & toast provided by the centre.
- Day Two Lunch - 6-item sandwich lunch bag made fresh each day by the centre.
