Roman pinch pots are simple, hand-pinched ceramic vessels created using the pinch pot method, a technique that has been employed since ancient times. These pots, made from a ball of clay by pressing the thumb into the center and then pinching the walls outward, served various functions from functional bowls to decorative items and burial urns. Their distinctive features include a hand-made, often less uniform appearance compared to wheel-thrown pottery.
